Education Records Bureau (ERB) Writing Assessment Program (WrAP) - Internal Writing Assessment for Grades 3-11: In addition to MAP testing, students in grades 3-11 also partake in an external writing assessment through WrAP which provides a direct measure of students' writing ability. During the assessment, students receive a writing prompt. Over two days, they have two 50-60 minute periods of time to independently develop a response to it. The first day is used to prepare the rough draft and the second day is used to produce a final copy. During the week of February 25th, students in grades 3-11 will be taking a practice writing assessment to prepare for formal writing assessment to be administered in April.
