ERB Formal Writing Assessment to be administered during the week of April 22nd. Students in Grades 3-11 will participate in AISN's external writing assessment. It will be administered over a consecutive 2-day period. On the first day, students receive a writing prompt and have a restricted amount of time to develop a first draft. On the second day of the assessment, students are required to produce a final copy of their writing from the previous day. Once the assessments are complete, they will be sent to America to be scored. Results will be available before the end of the school year.
