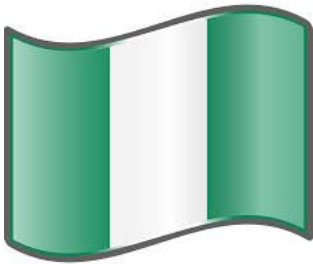


Important Information Regarding AISN Students and Internet Safety

We were recently alerted to the fact that AISN students, some as young as 2nd grade, are participating in inappropriate online group chats (Snapchat, Instagram, WhatsApp, TikTok, Facebook, Google Hangout) on their cell phones and computers. After some students from another Nouakchott school shared the content from their groups with educators, it was found that the groups contained mature content, inappropriate language, sexual references, and bullying behavior. These groups include AISN students, students outside of AISN, and unknown people. As this is occurring outside of school hours, we highly encourage you to check your child's phone and computer usage. In this age of technology, parents need to talk with their children about internet safety and be vigilant about what their children are accessing on their various electronic devices.
