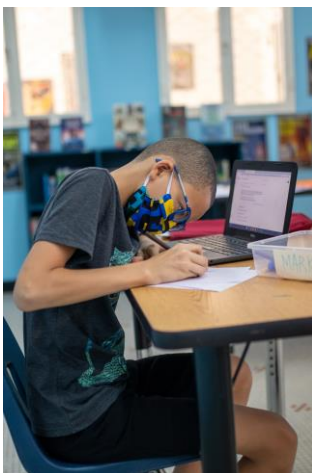

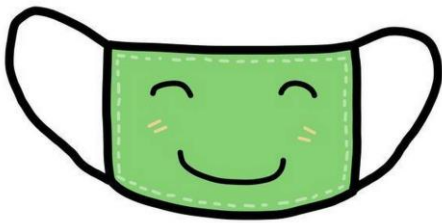
AISN WELCOMES STUDENTS BACK FOR FACE-TO-FACE LEARNING!
