Schedule of Tuition and Fees 2023-24

Tuition:

PreK \$8,000 per School Year
Kindergarten through Grade 5: \$17,400 per School Year
Grades 6-12: \$19,600 per School Year

Additional Fees for All Returning Students:

Annual capital development fee:* \$900 for all students Kindergarten through 12th

* Non-refundable

Additional One Time Fees for New Students:

One time capital development fee:* \$4,500 for new students Kindergarten through 12th

One time enrollment fee:* \$100 for new students

* Non-refundable

A \$500 non-refundable deposit will be required to guarantee your child's place following acceptance. This will be deducted from the first tuition invoice.

All fees are payable in USD or MRU

Multi-child discount: If tuition is not paid 100% by the sponsoring organization, there is a 5% discount if there are 3 or more children enrolled from the same immediate family.

Early payment discount: Families will receive a 5% discount on their total invoice if full year tuition is paid by May 31st. Families will receive a 2.5% discount on their total first semester invoice if the first semester tuition is paid by May 31st.

Laptop/Chromebook: All students from Grade 6 through Grade 12 are required to have their own laptop or Chromebook every day at school. If needed, Chromebooks are available for purchase from the school.

Following is an excerpt from the School's Board Policy Administrative Handbook with regards to Tuition and Fees:

4.2 Tuition

Tuition is reflective of the quality of the education program and the educational environment. While every effort is made to keep tuition as low as possible, the Board bears in mind the need to maintain the appropriate balance between the various demands and needs of the school that are supportive of the educational goals and objectives of the school. Generally, tuition policies are effective for the entire school year.

4.2.1 Payment of Tuition

All parents/guardians will be notified of details of the tuition and other fees due for the next school year at the end of the current school year. The tuition would be paid fully through US dollar cash, US dollar bank draft, US dollar check or Love of Learning • Critical Thinking • Respect Diversity • Intellectual Curiosity • Sense of Belonging



direct transfer, payable to the American International School of Nouakchott. Written proof of wire transfer of funds to the AISN Bank of America account from the sending or receiving bank is required before payment is considered made. Parents are responsible for any related bank fees.

4.2.2 Payment by Ouguiya

National Mauritanians and long-term residents whose primary income is in local currency may pay in local currency. Payment must be made at the US Embassy rate of exchange for the day the payment is made. Other requests for payment in local currency must be made in writing to the Board.

4.2.3 Payment Schedule

For tuition purposes, the school year is divided into two semesters. Students enrolling anytime during the first semester will pay the full year's tuition. Students enrolling during the second semester will be charged 50% of the annual tuition. Tuition may be paid for the full year or in two equal payments.

For returning students the following payment dates apply:

1st payment: ½ tuition no later than June 11th
2nd payment: ½ tuition no later than January 15th

Families will receive a 5% discount on their total invoice if full year tuition is paid by May 31st. Families will receive a 2.5% discount on their total first semester invoice if the first semester tuition is paid by May 31st.

Newly arrived students must pay all fees for the respective semester before being admitted to class. Any student enrolling after the 41st day of any semester will be allowed to pay ½ of that semester's tuition.

4.2.4 Late Payment

If tuition payment is more than 30 days past the invoice due date, the Director has the authority to remove the student from school. The Director, in consultation with the Board Treasurer, may grant exceptions.

4.2.5 Late Enrollment

Students enrolling late in school will be required to pay the entire tuition for the quarter being enrolled and for subsequent quarters.

4.2.6 Places Held

Embassies, NGOs and parents who wish to assure their children a place must reserve by paying a non-refundable \$500 deposit (deductible for their invoice) payment in advance. Places will not be held until payment is made. The Director will inform parents of potential students and other interested parties of the status of available slots.

4.2.7 Expulsion

In the event a student is expelled from school prior to the end of the quarter, tuition fees will not be refunded.

4.2.8 Refunds

Should a student leave the school for reasons not including expulsion, tuition, if paid in full, is refundable only for all unused quarters. Students leaving the school after spending any part of one quarter will not receive a refund for the remainder of the quarter. Any early payment discount previously given will be deducted from the refund. Capital development and first time enrollment fees are non-refundable.

4.2.9 Tuition credit transfer

AISN does not support any tuition credit transfer.

4.2.10 School Closure

In the event the school must be closed and is not re-opened in sufficient time to provide a minimum school year, the school will issue a refund for tuition for all unused but paid quarters. A minimum year will constitute 135 days. Refunds will be made by US dollar check or Mauritanian Ouguiya at the school's discretion.

4.2.11 Tuition Fees Increases

Tuition fees are established by the Board annually based on projected costs.

4.3 Financial Aid

Families with three or more children in their immediate family enrolled at AISN, who do not receive 100% tuition paid by a sponsor organization, will receive a discount of 5% on the total annual invoice.
